### From the local RC Archdiocese on House Bill 1032

Archbishop Aquila recently asked Catholics to speak out against House Bill 1032, a problematic bill that would require public and charter schools to either adopt a so-called comprehensive sex-ed curriculum, or to provide no instruction on sexuality at all. Almost 400 people showed up to the House Committee hearing for the bill last Wednesday and made their objections known about this troubling legislation.
