Pre-Lent

Starting after the Sunday of Zacchaeus (today-5 Sundays before the Great Fast (Lent) begins) we begin the Season of "Pre-Lent". This is a season of reflection on scriptural stories of repentance, and practical and spiritual preparation for the grave and substantial season of the Great Fast. We can make this season effective by meditating throughout the week on the Gospel of the previous Sunday, and by praying the Prayers of the "Lenten Triodion" (Morning and Evening Prayers during Pre-Lent and the Great Fast) that will be available on the daily Flocknote Prayer Resources (sign up if you haven't already at flocknote.com/HolyProtectionDenver). -You can also find lots of great resources for your children at www.byzimom.com.
